Important preparations! Online enrolment

- Upload documents online
- Pay semester fee
- After you have successfully enrolled, you can apply for a student ID card

Health insurance

- No travel insurance!
- Apply for insurance from abroad
- Contracts begin at the start of the semester
- Health insurance is mandatory for enrolment

Visa for study purpose

- No tourist visa
- Students from EU/EEA: no visa necessary; free entry and unlimited stay in Germany/Students from outside EU/EEA: visa is necessary
- Free service: Please use the code UNIGOETTINGEN25 to create your free account at https://platform.visaflow.app





Late arrivals

As a general rule

- Bachelor → no postponement of admission possible
- Master/PhD → send an E-Mail to the contact person in your <u>faculty</u> as the faculty decides:
 - if you can arrive later during the semester
 - or if your admission can be postponed to the next possible semester
 - or if you must apply again

Withdrawal of enrolment

- If you are already enrolled, you have the option to <u>withdraw your enrolment</u> until 27th of November 2025, so that the missed semester will not count.
- You can also request a <u>refund</u> of semester fees you have already paid until 27th of November 2025.





Finances – Cost of living



Cost of living: approx. 1000 € /month

- Accommodation = 300 400 €
- Food = 200 €
- Health insurance, costs for medical treatment, medication = 120 €
- Phone, internet, radio and broadcasting fee = 50 €
- Study materials & books etc. = 50 €
- Leisure time & miscellaneous = 150 €

+ semester fee = approx. 440 €/semester



Student Jobs



Scholarships

- All international students with a residence permit may work in Germany
- Students are allowed to work 140 full days or 280 half days (approx. 20 hours per week per calendar year)
- This includes student jobs in and outside the university, mini-jobs, and internships, but does not include freelance work
- The minimum wage is €12,82 per hour

Various scholarships also available to international students in Germany

- German universities do not normally provide scholarships, but external organizations do
- Important: Students are first considered for scholarships and funding programs once they have demonstrated significant achievements during their studies



Searching for Accommodation

- Many international students live in the student dorms (the <u>Studierendenwerk</u>) on campus, which provides low-priced housing
- The University's <u>Accommodation Support</u> provides information and guidance on the housing market in Göttingen



Buying SIM cards with prepaid function

- May be purchased online or at airports and shopping malls in Germany
- Costs: 5 30 € per month
 (Different services are available without contracts, including internet and SMS)
- Largest service providers: Telekom, Vodafone, O2



Electricity

- voltage 220V, 50 Hz AC
- Power plug in and adapter

Registration with the City of Göttingen



Registration at City Hall "Neues Rathaus" Hiroshimaplatz 1-4 37083 Göttingen



- Registration for ALL students as soon as possible after arrival
 - Appointments online available: https://termin.goettingen.de/
 - Keep your confirmation of Registration!
- Important documents:
 - Passport/ID card
 - Rental contract (Wohnungsgeberbestätigung)



Residence permit

- Deadline: 8-10 weeks before your visa expires; but if possible directly after registration with the city!
- Does not apply to EU nationals!
- Appointments: Email at <u>studierende@goettingen.de</u>
- Send applications by email
- Read the handout for the document list







Opening a Giro bank account





Which account do I need?

- Current account
- Transfer, cashless payment and debit cash at the ATM

What do I need to open an account?

- Passport
- Registration certificate of the city hall in Göttingen

How much do I have to pay?

- A lot of banks offer student accounts free of charge (Deutsche Bank, Commerzbank, Postbank, Santander)
- Some banks charge a monthly fee, prices vary




Medical care and emergencies



- ADFC bike school offers courses for adults (approx. 100€ fee)




Uses for your student ID card

 - Ride the city buses for free
 - Use the regional and local trains free of charge (not for use on IC or ICE trains)
 - Download digital ticket on mobile devices or use a chip card
